Italian firm wins hydrocarbons project

Italy's Maire Tecnimont has been awarded the estimated \$400m main contract to develop a liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) plant at Rhourde el-Baguel in Algeria, according to industry sources.

The two-and-a-half year contract includes gas processing units and an LPG extraction unit.

In September, MEED revealed that four companies were preparing to submit commercial bids for the project. These were India's Larsen & Toubro and South Korean firms Samsung Engineering and Daewoo, as well as Maire Tecnimont.

A total of nine engineering, procurement and construction contractors were initially invited to participate in the tender. They were:

- Hyundai Engineering & Contracting (South Korea)
- JGC (Japan)
- Larsen & Toubro (India)
- Maire Tecnimont (Italy)
- Samsung Engineering (South Korea)

Rhourde el-Baguel field

The facility is due to be developed near the Rhourde el-Baguel oil field in Algeria's Ouargla Province. It is Algeria's second-biggest field and was discovered in 1963 and developed in 1996.
